Sacred Hearts School has been serving the Maui community since 1862 and has received the highest possible WASC/WCEA school accreditation rating. We are proud to provide excellent academic instruction and build strong spiritual foundation through Catholic values.

Over the years and due to our current situation we would like to address the following:

- ❖ Parents are interested in a Catholic High School option at Sacred Hearts School. Parents want their children to continue their Catholic education after graduating from Sacred Hearts School.
- ❖ Parents are interested in a location friendly High School option. The closest Catholic High School, St. Anthony, is about 1-1.5 hours away. The long commute is exhausting and difficult due to traffic and other incidents that cause the road to close leaving commuters stranded.
- ❖ Provide parents with a reasonably priced Catholic High School option. There are two High Schools in West Maui, Lahainaluna High School, public school and Maui Preparatory School with a \$22,000 tuition.

OVERVIEW

Catholic Virtual, a program of Virtual Schools of Excellence, is an educational organization with college-board approved classes offered through a comprehensive “e-learning” online environment.

Catholic Virtual is a virtual college preparatory school that provides students with a highly engaging, academically rigorous program designed to challenge each student to achieve the highest academic standards possible. It is accredited by the North Central Association Commission on Accreditation and School Improvement (NCA CASI), the Northwest Accreditation Commission (NWAC) and the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools council on Accreditation and School Improvement (SACS CASI), the regional accrediting agencies that span the AdvancedED global network of over 32,000 schools and systems in more than 70 countries. Student that have gone through the Catholic Virtual program have a 99% graduation rate.

The classes are completely web-based and consist of a combination of teacher-directed independent study and once a week live webinars. All school work would be submitted and assessed through the Catholic Virtual learning management system, Maestro. Through the Maestro platform, students would be expected to spend an average of 30 hours per week on coursework, be held accountable for their progress and grades, work independently, and be responsible for logging in daily. They will also participate in live sessions, socratic webinars, on line chat sessions, tutoring, other interactive activities, communicate with teachers and academic success coaches on a regular basis, and enjoy peer-to-peer collaboration activities and projects.

Co-op classes will be provided 2-4 times a week for 45 minutes mainly on Tuesdays and Thursdays and are subject to change.
