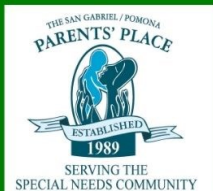

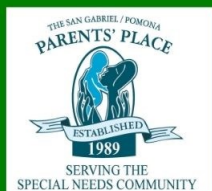

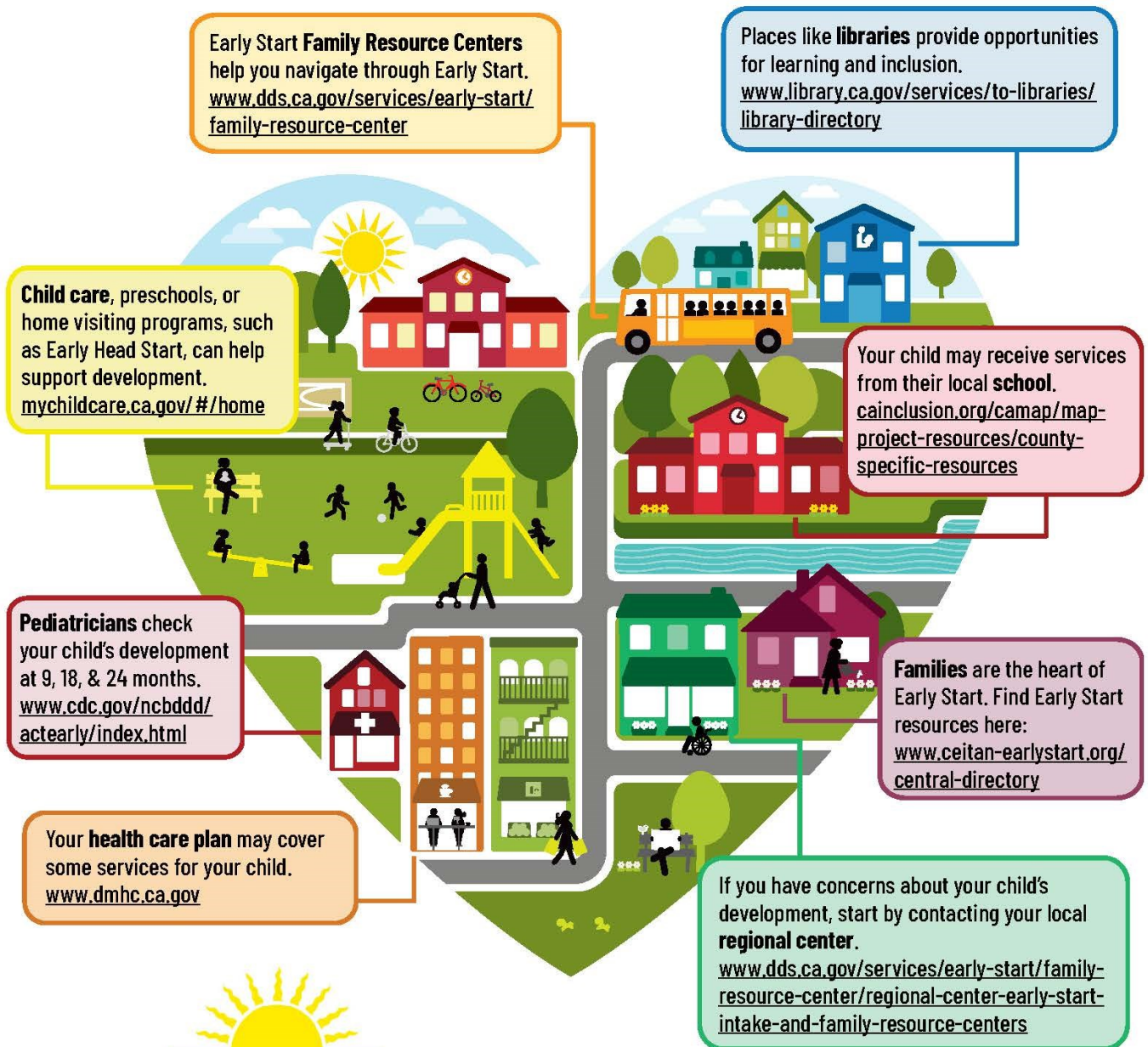

Guiding the Journey: A Two-Part Series for Parents and Caregivers Navigating Part C to Part B Transitions



Families play a vital role in tracking progress and advocating for their child's needs as they prepare for the next stage in their educational journey. Parents, caregivers, education specialists, and family support providers are invited to join this two-part no-cost, virtual series focused on Parts C and B of the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA).

The first session, scheduled for November 18, 2025, will focus on Part C of IDEA, also known as Early Start, which provides services for infants and toddlers from birth to age 2 years, 11 months, who have developmental delays or diagnosed disabilities. As a child approaches age three, the early intervention team begins working with the family and local school district to plan a smooth transition to school district services under Part B. This session will cover what parents need to know about transition, including assessments, services, the Individualized Family Service Plan (IFSP), timelines, and parent rights. Additional resources, including information about Community Resource and Empowerment Centers, will be shared.

The second session, on March 30, 2026, will address the transition to Part B (school district services), including the assessment process, the purpose of the Individualized Education Program (IEP), team membership, and what to expect during the first IEP meeting. Parent rights and responsibilities will be reviewed, and digital and community-based resources—including information about Family Resource and Empowerment Centers—will be provided. With knowledge and collaboration, families can help ensure a successful transition for their child.

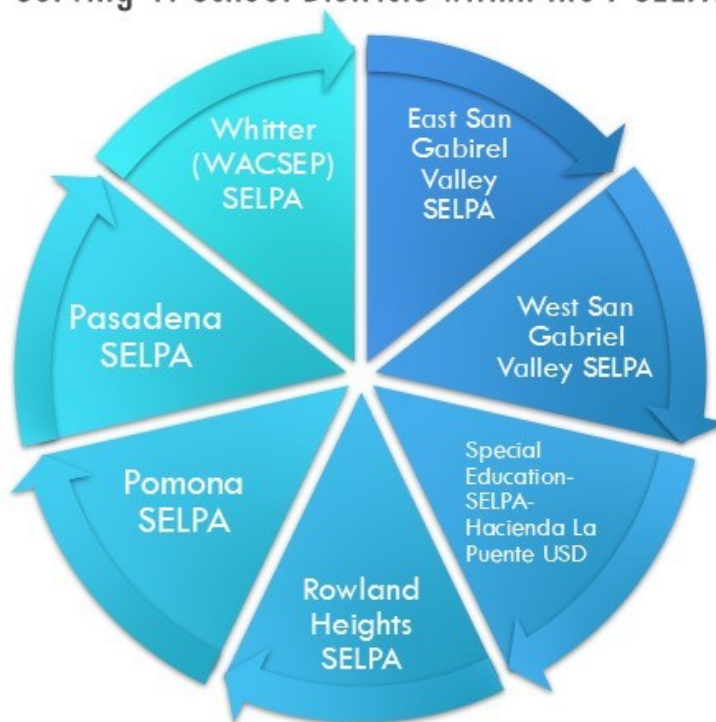
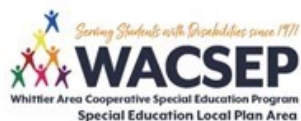

The Foundations of IDEA and a Look Back

HISTORY OF THE IDEA

The Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA), originally enacted in 1975 as the Education for All Handicapped Children Act, was born from the civil rights movement to ensure equal educational access for children with disabilities.

Influenced by landmark cases like *Brown v. Board of Education* and *PARC v. Pennsylvania*, the law mandated a Free Appropriate Public Education (FAPE) in the Least Restrictive Environment (LRE).

Renamed IDEA in 1990, it expanded to include autism and traumatic brain injury, and later amendments emphasized parental involvement, transition services, and alignment with broader education reforms. Subsequent amendments in 1997 and 2004 strengthened its provisions.

Though the federal full funding promise has not been fulfilled to date, IDEA continues to be the foundation of special education in the U.S., guaranteeing students with disabilities the right to learn and thrive.

The Five Protective Factors

The Protective Factors are the foundation of the Strengthening Families approach. Extensive research supports the common sense notion that when these five Protective Factors are present and robust in a family, the likelihood of child abuse and neglect diminish.

Parental Resilience: The ability to cope and bounce back from all types of challenges.

Social Connections: Friends, family members, neighbors, and other members of a community who provide emotional support and concrete assistance to parents.

Knowledge of Parenting and Child Development: Accurate information about raising young children and appropriate expectations for their behavior.

Concrete Support in Times of Need: Financial security to cover day-to-day expenses and unexpected costs that come up from time to time. Access to formal supports like TANF, Medicaid and informal supports from social networks.

Children's Social and Emotional Development: A child's ability to interact positively with others and communicate his or her emotions and needs effectively.
